ARTS FOR AWARENESS COMPETITION

As part of **HER Breast Friends** 10th anniversary in 2015 the Charity is holding a series of roadshows/exhibitions to promote the Charity's services and activities and to highlight the positive and therapeutic impact that inspiring arts and crafts can have on those affected by the disease.

The competition is open to all amateur artists/crafters and children, all we ask is that you relate your entry either to the Charity itself, or to a person you know who has been affected by breast cancer. This can be done through your piece of work or the written Artist's Statement/Personal Paragraph.

We are holding a series of roadshows/exhibitions in Hull and across the East Riding of Yorkshire to exhibit the entries and obtain public votes to determine the competition winners - no personal attendance is necessary.

The theme for our special year is 'From Caterpillars to Butterflies' to demonstrate the growth and development of **HER Breast Friends** and the strengths, qualities and values at the very heart of the Charity: the ability to inspire, encourage, and transform fearful negatives into real and lasting positives. Your entry can reflect this or you can choose your own theme.

Please note that all entries are to be accompanied by a written Artist's Statement or Personal Paragraph' of up to 50 words briefly describing how breast cancer has affected you or someone close to you, or how your entry links to the Charity, and how this inspired your competition entry.

Competition Rules/Terms & Conditions

Entry is FREE and open to all amateur artists/crafters and children although a donation to **HER Breast Friends** would be greatly appreciated for all entries sold as a direct result of the competition and/or exhibitions.

All entries are to be accompanied by a completed entry form and a written 'Artist's Statement' or 'Personal Paragraph' of around 50 words briefly describing how breast cancer has affected you or someone close to you, or how your entry links to the Charity, and how this has inspired your competition entry.

In the case of entries from those under the age of 16 a parent or guardian can submit the paragraph on behalf of the child.

A maximum of four entries per person.

Entries must be original.

A joint entry is acceptable.

Art work and photography must be framed and strung for hanging.

We reserve the right not to accept or display entries. This may also apply to some 3D entries that are not considered suitable for open display or a touring exhibition.

HER Breast Friends does not accept liability for loss or damage to entries and you are recommended to arrange your own insurance cover.

Entries will be judged by public vote and the results will be made available from 10am on Tuesday 13 September 2015 from the **HER Breast Friends** office or via the website or social media accounts.

Print your name, address and telephone number on the back of your entry and/or on a securely attached label.

Closing date for entries to be submitted is Tuesday 24 March 2015 and no late entries will be accepted (*except for very exceptional circumstances at the discretion of the Competition Secretary*)

Entries, along with a completed and signed entry form, should be brought to: The Community Centre, Elm Avenue, Garden Village, Hull, HU8 8PZ on Tuesday 24 March during the hours of 10am and 2pm when a photograph of the entrant with their entry will be taken. Entries will only be accepted on other days or times by prior arrangement only.

HER Breast Friends must be allowed to exhibit/display the winning items and use/photograph them for publicity purposes throughout 2015.

After the final exhibition is over entries will be available for collection from Hull Central Library, Albion Street, Hull, HU1 3TE on Saturday 17 October 2015 between the hours of 12 noon and 2pm. After that they will be disposed of, or sold, unless prior arrangements for collection have been agreed with the Competition Secretary.
